

How to make a bar graph of species seen in different habitats - manually

1. List the habitat codes across the white board
2. List the species seen under the appropriate habitats
3. Total the number of species
4. Draw the “x” and “y” lines
5. Put a “0” at the bottom, “1”, “2” etc. up the “y” axis (vertical)
6. Put the habitat codes along the “x” axis (horizontal)
7. Draw a rectangle from the “x” axis to the correct number on the “y” axis
8. Repeat for each habitat
9. Label the “x” axis “Habitat Code”
10. Label the “y” axis “How Many” or “Quantity”
11. Explain what the graph is showing
